The take up of Covid Booster vaccines has been impressive in Staffordshire.

The vaccine provider guidelines currently dictate that we can book the over 50s and patients who are immunosuppressed.

Face the Facts

From the 11,000 patients registered with BMP a total of **79%** have had two doses of the Covid Vaccination.

60% of BMPs eligible patients have had their booster shot too!

Knowing Me, Knowing Flu

Demand for the flu vaccine is unprecedented this year and juggling flu and Covid Booster vaccines has been a task in itself.

Since September, Team Brewood has vaccinated 3140 patients at the surgery or as a home visit against seasonal influenza.

Coupled with the Covid Booster, this strengthens 'community immunity' during the Winter months.

During September and October 2021 there were over 250 wasted appointments where patients did not attend.


